**Mesa Falcon Field (FFZ)  
Aviation Activity Forecast Approval**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has reviewed the aviation forecast for the Mesa Falcon Field Airport (FFZ) submitted May 15, 2018. The FAA approves both this forecast and the use of B-II for both the existing and future critical design aircraft for airport planning purposes, including Airport Layout Plan development.

The forecast was developed using current data and appropriate methodologies and despite the forecast not being within the acceptable range of TAF tolerance in the 10-year forecast period, the variance was sufficiently explained in the submittal. Therefore the forecast is approved for planning purposes at FFZ. It is important to note that the approval of this forecast doesn't guarantee funding for large scale capital improvements as future projects will need to be justified by current activity levels at the time the projects are proposed for implementation.
